

JUNK IS KEY TO MY BUSINESS

A CITY banker who swapped the Square Mile for the municipal rubbish dump has won a new award for entrepreneurs. Jason Mohr founded clearance business Any Junk? to pick up and recycle, or dispose of, any rubbish from furniture to construction waste. He has made £140,000 in revenue from more than 900 jobs since its launch last November. Mr Mohr, 36, said: 'I enjoy the energy and excitement that comes with such a fast growing company.'
